If these precautions are not strictly followed, your procedure may have to be cancelled.

- Arrange for transportation to and from the hospital and/or surgery center. You can not take bus or a taxi
- If you take medications on a daily basis, you should notify our office of the name of the medication and the reason you take it. It may be necessary to change the time you take your medication.
- **No aspirin or ibuprofen two weeks prior to surgery.**
- Call our office if you develop a fever or other symptoms of a cold, flu or respiratory infection.
- All minors must be accompanied by a legal guardian.
- Leave all jewelry and valuables at home.
- Wear casual, loose fitting clothing.
- Leave contact lenses at home.
- It is preferable that your acrylic nails be removed prior to your procedure (or as directed by your surgeon).
- Be prompt – you should arrive at the location of your surgery at the time listed for your arrival.
- Bring all insurance cards and photo identification. All deductibles and co-pays are due at the time of registration.
